Science Corner,

Greeting fellow gentle beings,

As I write this it is day 8 of the new administration of STARFLEET. Most of you probably already know this but Reed Bates, our very own Operations officer, is the newest Vice Commander, STARFLEET. When you have a chance, send her your congratulations!

As a second piece of (what some would call) *good news*, as it happens, I am the new Vice Chief of Computer Operations. You may send your congratulations or condolences as you feel led. I am working with Larry French, the new CompOps Chief and I can tell you right now that we have had to hit the ground running.

Now on to some science news:

You may have heard that China landed a lander on our moon last month. Yes, with the help of Russian technology, the Chinese have become the third nation to safely land a craft on the moon while maintaining operation of the vehicle. Right now there is a little rover roving its' way into history on our planet's only satellite. For those of you who are unsettled at China's recent success, I can only say that despite the fact that an evil nation that crushes dissent and invades neighboring countries (like Tibet) — murdering its' previously peaceful people and smashing all freedom of expression, there is an upside to this event. This accomplishment by this repressive and murderous regime will likely spur a new "Space Race" between China and the benevolent and peace-loving nations of the world. Yes, indeed, we may even spend more than the current 0.5% that NASA is currently (graciously) granted by our nations leaders.

In other news, the Cygnus spacecraft, built by Orbital Sciences will be making its' first official cargo run to the Space Station Freedom (the International Space Station). The unmanned Cygnus spacecraft is packed with 2,780 pounds (1,260 kilograms) of gear for the International Space Station, including a space ant colony, 33 small cubesat satellites and 23 other experiments designed students from across the country. More than 10,000 students will ultimately be involved in the experiments, NASA officials said.

A Space-X Falcon 9 rocket blasted into orbit on January 6th, delivering yet another privately launched payload into space. This time, the heroes of private spaceflight transported into a high altitude orbit a communications satellite for a Thai company. Each launch of the Space X Falcon 9 is less than half of the cost of any other vehicle, excepting the Cygnus rocket (Orbital Sciences).

If it isn't quite obvious to you now, the answer to this month's theme question ("If you lived in the Star Trek Universe what race, job, and time would you want to live) is, of course, a Vulcan Scientist. Scientists (when left unfettered by oppressive regimes and theological meddling) create the niftiest stuff.
